Finding the right provider

It's important to have a primary care provider (PCP) who helps you feel comfortable. Molina has a large network of providers to serve our members.

A PCP is a personal doctor who takes care of basic health needs including physical exams, HIV and AIDS testing, colds and flu, sexually transmitted disease (STD) treatment, and general health screenings.

Taking care of the whole you

Did you know? About 1 in 5 adults in the U.S. live with mental illness (over 46 million people), and only half of them get treatment.*

Members of the LGBTQ+ community are almost 3 times more likely than others to experience a mental health condition such as major depression or generalized anxiety disorder.**

Molina covers mental health services for our Apple Health (Medicaid) members from caring providers.

Mental health services can include:

- Evaluation and Diagnosis
- Medication Management
- Psychiatric and Psychological Testing
- Treatment and Counseling

Transgender member services

Molina Apple Health covers the following for our transgender members:

- Puberty blocking agents: adolescents (prior authorization, or PA, required); your PCP must get permission from Molina ahead of time
- Hormone therapy: all ages (many options are preferred; no PA required)
- Mental health services (mostly preferred; no PA required; some limits on psychotropics for children under age 18)

Molina's transgender health services are supported by the Case Management department.

Most surgical services are covered by fee-for-service, which you may know as ProviderOne (your blue colored services card). These services may be provided by any provider who accepts Apple Health, with prior authorization by the Health Care Authority.
